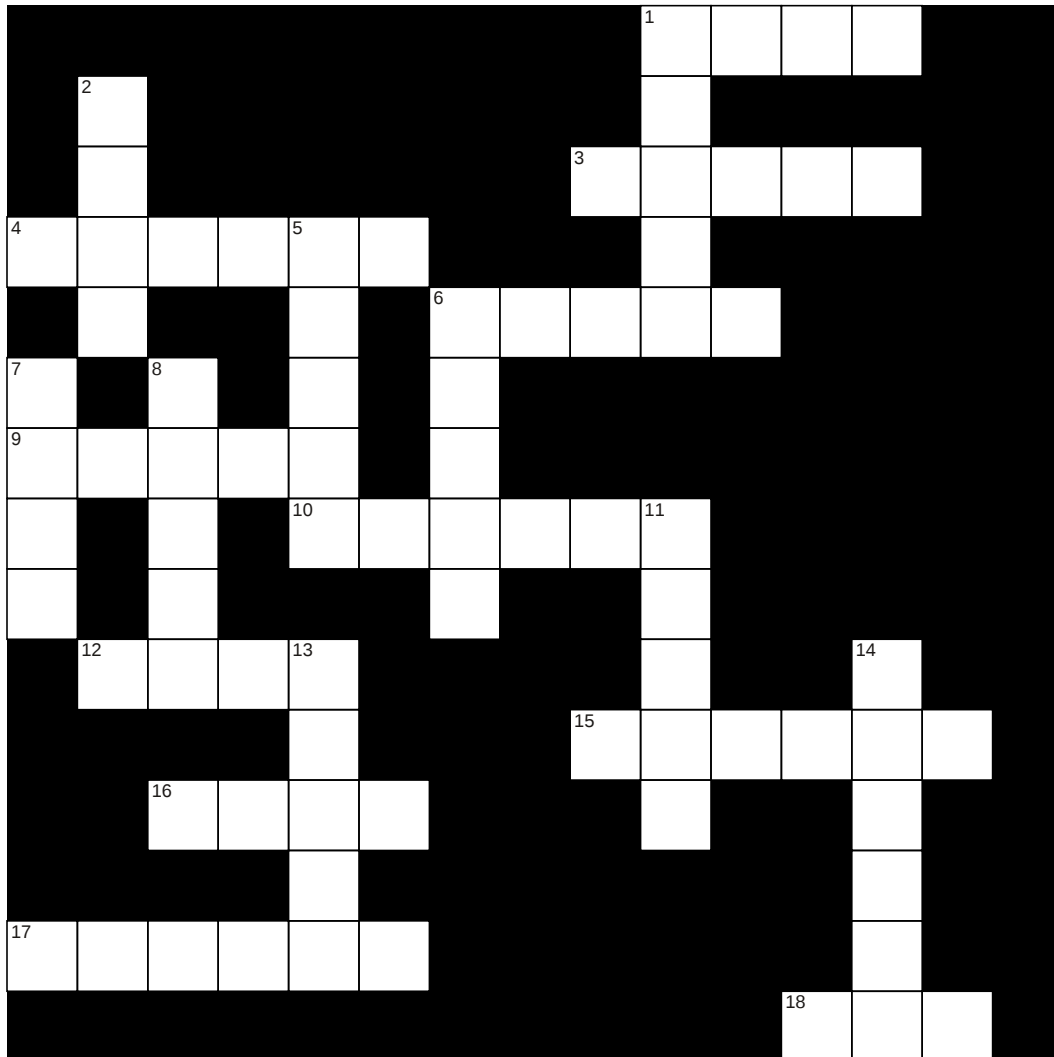


Calming the Storm

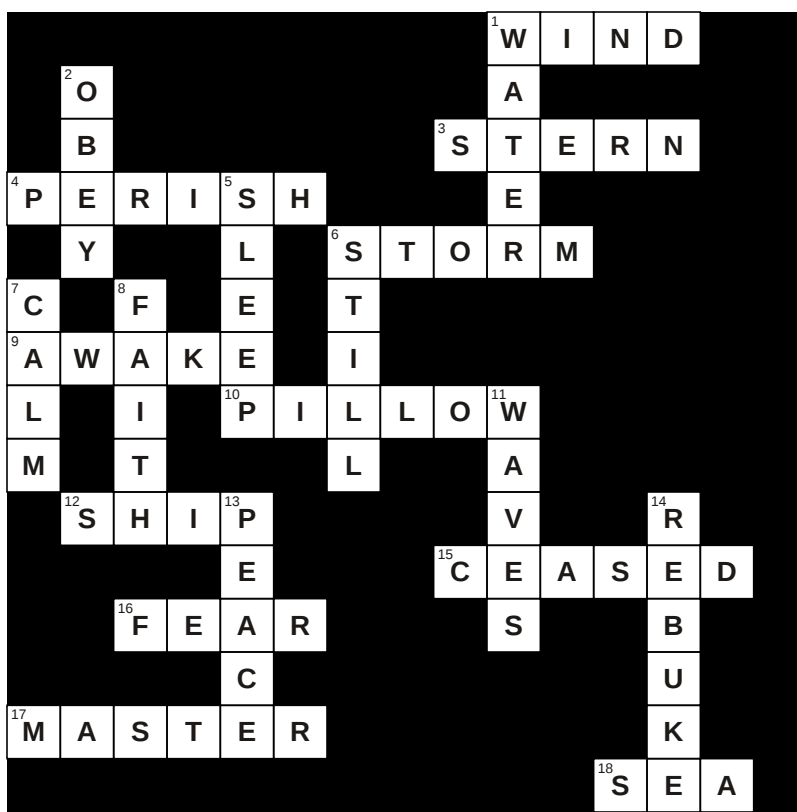
1. What Jesus rebuked first (4)
