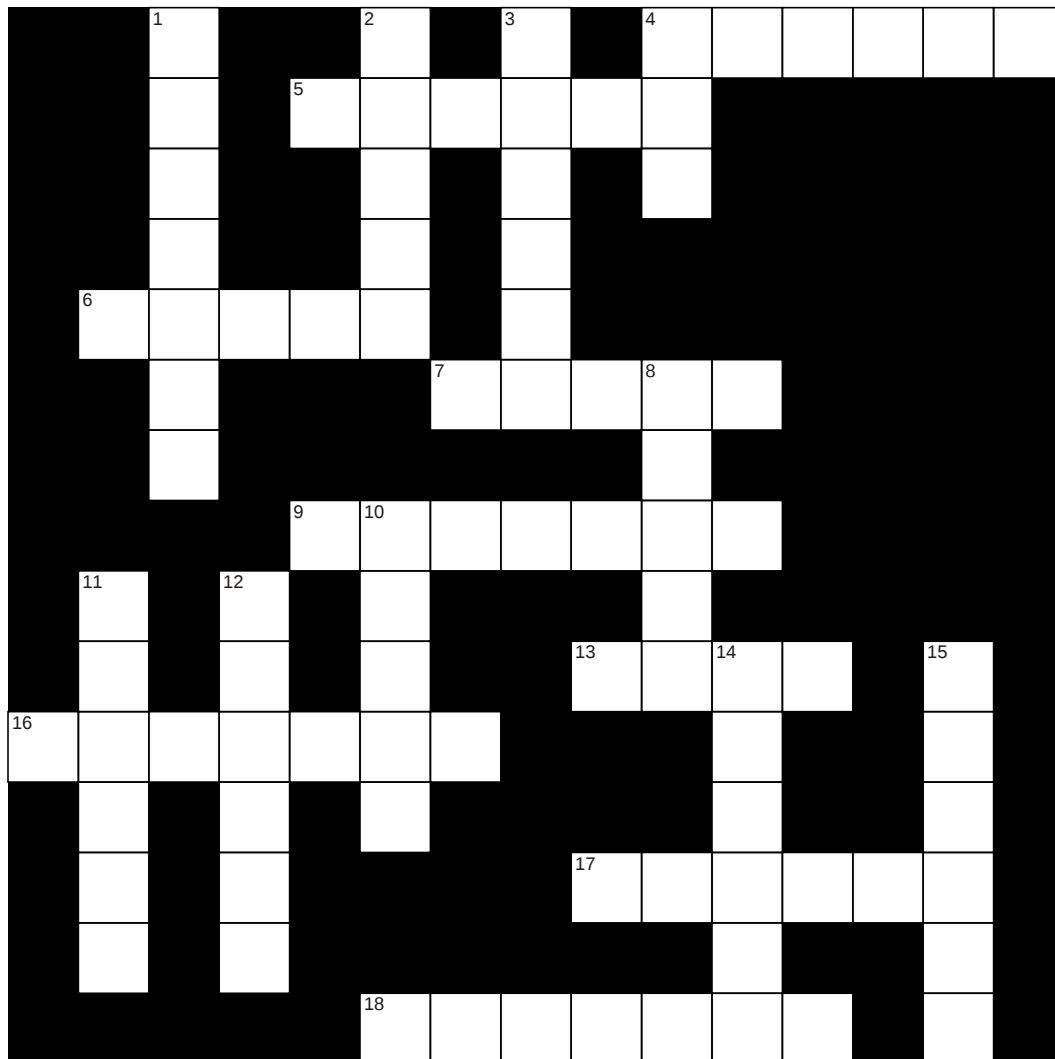


Daniel in the Lions' Den

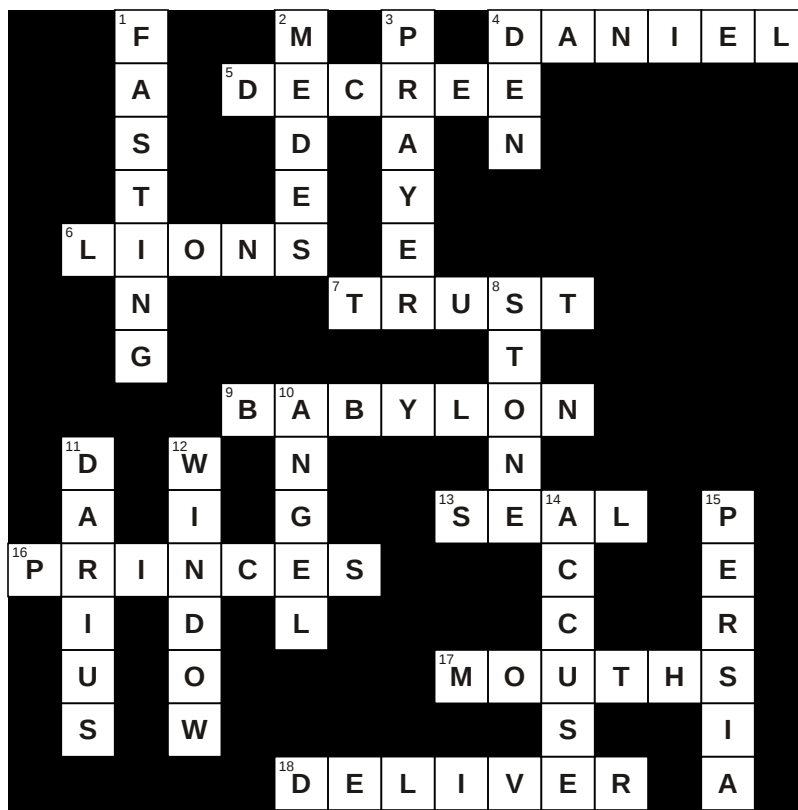
