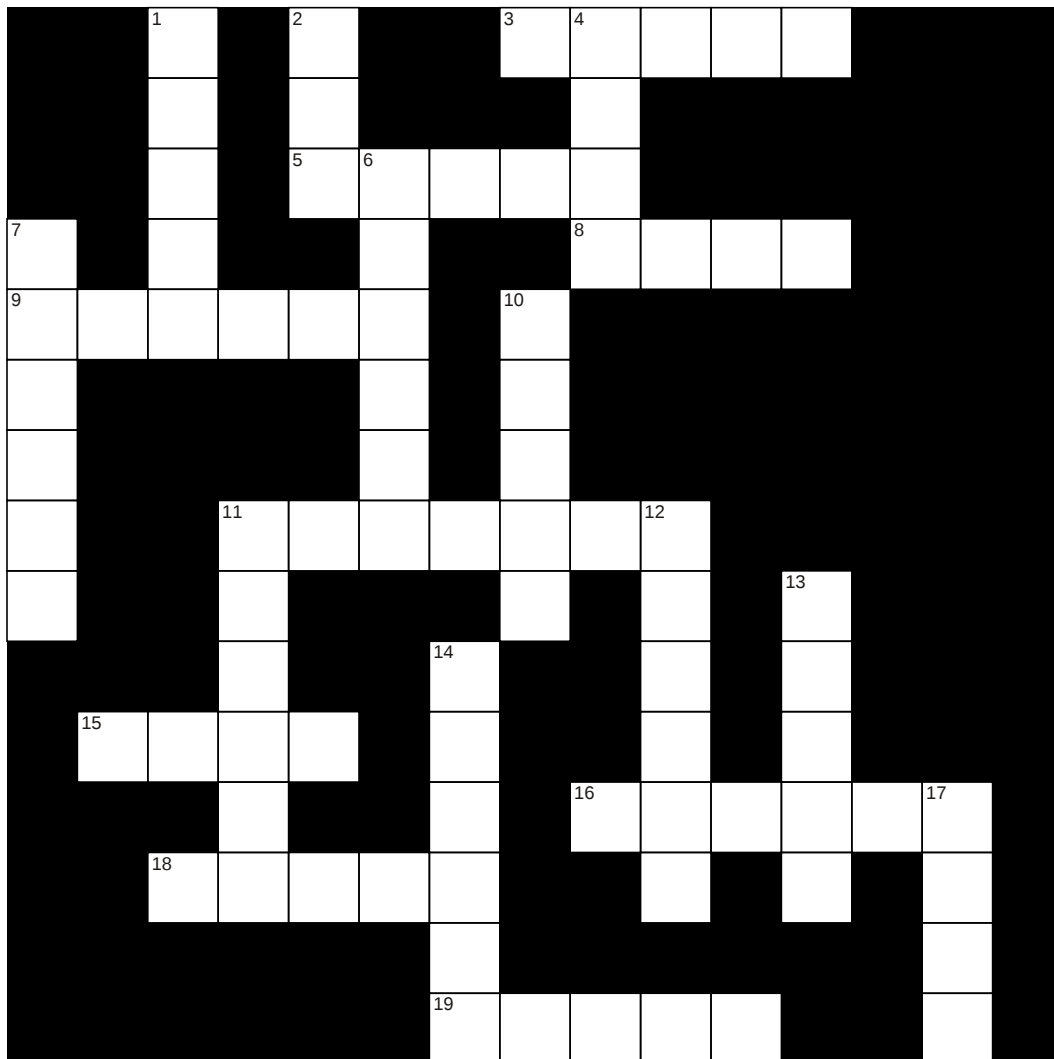


Manna in the Wilderness

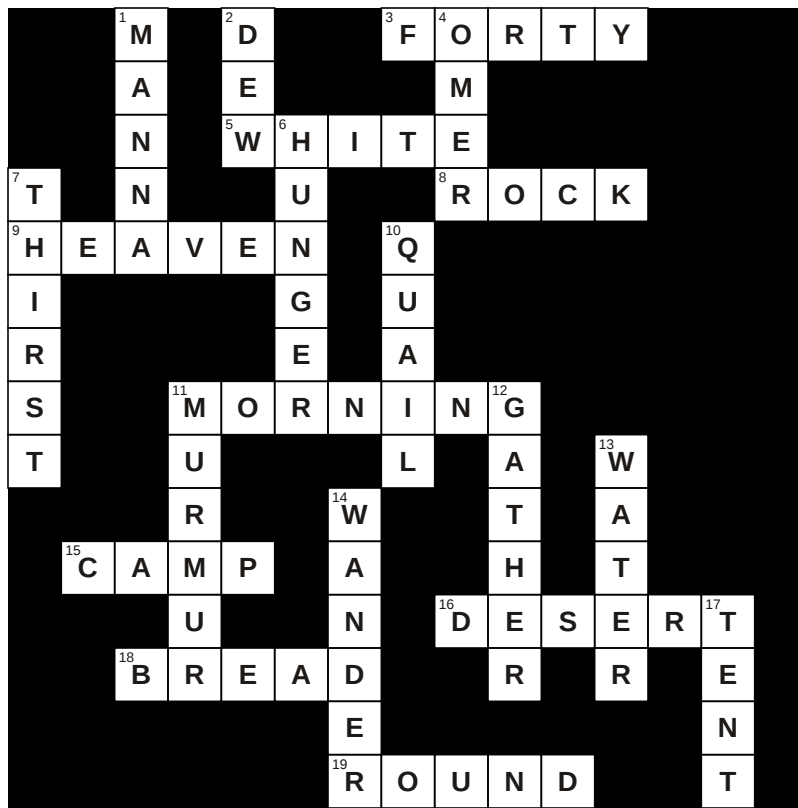
- 3. Number of years spent in the wilderness (5)
